08:30 Pick you up from your hotel by All Lao Travel Service office

08:50 Bike training by an experienced instructor

09:00 Visit Ban Pha-Nom “ Lao weaving village ”

09:50 Arrive at All Lao Elephant Camp (the best elephant camp in the Lao PDR)

12:30 Lao - style lunch at the elephant camp

13:30 Continue your cycling to Ban Ensavanh Village

14:00 Arrive at Ban Ensavanh Village
